Homestay Preferences

- There is another form to fill out. This one is for us to send to the German Hosts. They will then match you with a family.
- I prefer for you to stay alone with a family. This is by far the best experience we can have. If you decide to deviate from this, please email me and I will communicate this to the Germans.

Forms and Passport Update

- Here are the forms needed for the trip. All forms must be fully completed and appropriately signed. Notary Public's will be on stage afterwards for anyone who needs to get something signed.
 - Form 1 Code of Conduct due February 1st
 Student and Parent must sign
 - Form 2 Release Parents and Student– NOTARIZE due February 1st – Student and Parent both sign separate pages
 - Form 3 Medical NOTARIZE due February 1st
 Group travel medical insurance being purchased
 - 4. Google Form due February 1st– Student and parent should fill this out together
 - Copy of Passport due January 15

 A color copy of your actual passport (not the application). Needed early for group rates. Required for international travel
 - 6. Student Information for German Host Families due March 3
 A document that needs to have a photo attached to it.

Health Insurance

- Group coverage being purchased through IMG Global, <u>Patriot</u> <u>Group Exchange Program</u>.
- Cost is \$42. This is being purchased as a group. Not optional.
- \$100,000 medial insurance coverage.
- Most likely, treatment would be low cost or free anyway.
- Please check your health insurance cards and send a PDF copy of the card in to us. This is our secondary line of defense if needed. It is great information to have on hand.

Optional Trip Insurance

- This is a personal option for anyone who wants that security if our trip is cancelled for some reason.
- Many companies available. Here is one option: <u>Allianz Travel Insurance</u>

Travel Tips and Suggestions

- Keep your passport and money in a safe place such as on the front of you under your clothes.
- We will have cello/bass buddy as violin/ viola players will need to have their instruments as their carry-on. A buddy will save space for you in their carry-on.
- We recommend getting a safe travel bag.
